**Pinot Grigio (A)** £27.95

Montemarino, Pavia, Italy

Bright and refreshing with a touch of pear and floral aromas.

**Sauvignon Blanc (A)** £26.00

Monte Verde, Central Valley, Chile

Tantalisingly fresh with succulent gooseberry and fruit flavours.

**Reisling-Gewurztraminer (B)** £26.95

Kells Edge, Australia

Medium with hints of citrus and abundant lychee fruit flavours, combine to make this a very enjoyable easy drinking wine.

**Chardonnay (D)** £34.95

Blackstone, Monterey County, California

Bright refreshing citrus aromas combine with ripe tropical flavours and soft rounded smooth oak ageing.

**Marsanne Viognier (B)** £29.00

Rare Vineyards, Pays d'Oc, France

Honeysuckle and peach aromas combine with soft ripe apple fruit flavours.

**Chablis (C)** £39.00

Gloire de Chablis, Moreau, Chablis, France

Delicate green fruits and a flinty backbone deliver a complex range of flavours and aromas in this classic French wine.

**Sauvignon Blanc (C)** £44.95

Cloudy Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand

Highly sought-after for its vibrant aromatics, layers of pure fruit flavours and fine structure.

**Catarratto (A)** £23.95

Sun Tree, Sicily, Italy

Clean and fruity, but not too heavy. Touches of ripe peachy fruits combine with delicate citrus notes.

**Chenin Blanc (D)** £27.95

Kleine Zalze, Vineyard Selection, South Africa

A full wine, exploding with soft green and tropical fruits and many complex flavour profiles. Barrel fermented to make it perfect with richer white meat dishes.

**Sancerre (C)** £39.00

La Fuzelle, A, Marechal, Loire, France

Elegant with graceful hints of green grass and grapefruit, a classic mineral vein to finish.

Reims, Champagne, France

85% Pinot grapes gives this Champagne its stylish, full bodied character whilst retaining a freshness which is the feature of all Piper-Heidsieck wines.

Cuvée Brut Rosé NV**

Tours-sur-Marne, Champagne, France

Highly regarded this full flavoured, soft textured Champagne is salmon-pink in colour. Fresh and complex with crisp flavours of soft red fruits.

Champagne, France

Left to mature for 7 years before release, this classic Champagne is a fitting tribute to the monk from Hautvillers perfected the Champagne making method.

**Veuve Clicquot Yellow

Reims, Champagne, France

Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a rich, creamy style with biscuity flavours.

### Red

**Merlot (E) £26.00**

Monte Verde, Central Valley, Chile

Soft and juicy with hints of red berries and plums.

**Fleurie (E) £39.00**

Château de Fleurie, Beaujolais, France

A fine example of this classic 'cru' Beaujolais; ripe strawberry fruits and soft succulent flavours.

**Cabernet (E) £23.95**

Sun Tree, Veneto, Italy

Smooth and juicy with hints of ripe blackcurrant and a mellow refined finish.

**Pinot Noir (F) £39.50**

Robert Mondavi, California, USA

Aromas and flavours of dark fruits merge with notes of spice, herbs and subtle oak. With a long, smooth finish this is a richly satisfying wine.

**Chianti (F) £28.95**

Piccini, Tuscany, Italy

Soft cherry fruit with a velvety texture and an elegant delicate finish of spicy cherry.

**Rioja Tinto (F) £29.95**

Faustino VII, Tinto, Rioja, Spain

Smooth savoury flavours with hints of wild mushrooms and warming vanilla oak.

**Shiraz (G) £26.95**

Solstice, Sicily, Italy

Abundant ripe cherry fruits with hints of black pepper and a lingering smoky finish. Great with something from the grill.

**Reserva Malbec (G) £29.95**

Finca Flichman, Mendoza, Argentina

Terrific intensity of colour. Rich well structured with strong, peppery, slightly earthy flavours.

**Cabernet Sauvignon (H) £29.95**

Erazuriz, 1870 Mapuche Block, Aconcagua Valley, Chile

Juicy blackcurrant fruit flavours and a touch of vanilla spice on the palate.

**Lussac Saint-Emilion (H) £37.95**

Château Lyonnat, Bordeaux, France

Hints of cedar wood, plum and blackcurrant, combine with a refinement and elegance, perfect claret with red meat dishes and cheeses.

**Châteauneuf-du-Pape (G) £43.95**

Domaine de l'Arnesque, Rhône Valley, France

A fine example of this famous wine, full flavoured, ripe and juicy. Aged for 8 months in oak casks.
